## PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") describes how [COMPANY NAME] ("we", "us", or "our") collects, uses, discloses, and protects personal information through our website located at [WEBSITE URL] (the "Site"), mobile applications, products, and services (collectively, the "Services"). ### 1. Parties

2.2. "Processing" means any operation performed on Personal Data, including collection, storage, use, disclosure, transfer, or deletion.

### 3. Categories of Information We Collect

3.1. Information You Provide: We may collect information you provide directly, including:

3.1.1. Account information: name, email address, username, password, telephone number, billing and shipping information.

3.1.2. Communications: messages, questions, and other correspondence you send to us.

3.1.3. Content: information you post, upload, or submit through the Services.

3.2. Automatically Collected Information: When you use the Services we may automatically collect:

3.2.1. Usage data: pages viewed, features used, session length, and similar analytics.

3.2.2. Device and technical data: IP address, device identifiers, browser type and version, operating system, mobile network information, and diagnostic data.

3.2.3. Cookies and tracking technologies: see Section 8.

3.3. Information from Third Parties: We may receive information about you from third parties, such as advertising partners, analytics providers, social networks, and public sources.

### 4. How We Use Personal Information

We use Personal Information for the following purposes:

4.1. To provide, operate, and maintain the Services;

4.2. To process and fulfill orders, payments, and account management;

4.3. To communicate with you, including customer support, updates, and legal notices;

4.4. To personalize and improve the Services, including recommending content and features;

4.5. To detect, prevent, and respond to fraud, security incidents, and abuse;

4.6. To comply with legal obligations and enforce our terms and policies;

4.7. For any other purpose to which you consent.

## **5. Legal Bases for Processing (where required)**

If you are in a jurisdiction that requires us to identify a legal basis for processing Personal Data (e.g., the EU General Data Protection Regulation), we rely on one or more of the following legal grounds:

- 5.1. Performance of a contract: processing necessary to provide the Services or perform our contract with you;
- 5.2. Legitimate interests: processing necessary for our legitimate business purposes, such as improving services, preventing fraud, and ensuring network and information security, balanced against your rights and interests;
- 5.3. Consent: where you have given clear consent to the processing for specific purposes (such as marketing or cookies that are not strictly necessary);
- 5.4. Legal compliance: processing necessary to comply with statutory obligations.

## **6. Sharing and Disclosure of Personal Information**

- 6.1. Service Providers: We may share Personal Information with third-party vendors, service providers, and contractors who perform services on our behalf (e.g., hosting, payment processing, analytics, email delivery). These parties act as processors under applicable law and are bound by contractual confidentiality and security obligations.
- 6.2. Affiliates and Business Transfers: We may share Personal Information with our affiliates or in connection with a merger, acquisition, financing, or sale of assets, provided the recipient agrees to process Personal Information in a manner consistent with this Policy.
- 6.3. Legal Requirements and Protection: We may disclose Personal Information to comply with laws, regulations, legal processes, or government requests; to protect the rights, property, or safety of [COMPANY NAME], our users, or others; or to detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security, or technical issues.
- 6.4. Aggregate or De-identified Information: We may share aggregated or de-identified information that does not identify you.

## **7. International Transfers**

- 7.1. Our Services may involve transfers of Personal Information to, and processing in, countries other than your country of residence, including the United States. Those countries may have different data protection laws.
- 7.2. Where required by law, we implement appropriate safeguards for transfers, such as standard contractual clauses, binding corporate rules, or other lawful transfer mechanisms. Contact us at [CONTACT EMAIL] to request a copy of the safeguard documentation.

## **8. Cookies and Tracking Technologies**

- 8.1. We and our partners use cookies, web beacons, pixels, SDKs, and similar technologies to collect information about your interactions with the Services.
- 8.2. Purposes include: functioning of the site, remembering preferences, measuring site performance, analytics, and advertising personalization.
- 8.3. You may manage cookie preferences through your browser settings or via any opt-out mechanisms we provide. Disabling certain cookies may affect functionality.

## **9. Third-Party Services and Links**

- 9.1. The Services may contain links to third-party websites, products, or services not operated or controlled by [COMPANY NAME]. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of third parties. Review the privacy policies of those third parties before providing Personal Information.
- 9.2. We may allow third parties to collect information through our Services for analytics or advertising. These third parties may use cookies or similar technologies and may collect Personal Information for

## **10. Data Security**

10.1. We implement commercially reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect Personal Information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

10.2. No security system is impenetrable. If a security incident affects your Personal Information, we will notify you and regulators as required by applicable law and take steps to mitigate harm.

## **11. Data Retention**

11.1. We retain Personal Information only as long as necessary to provide the Services, fulfill the purposes described in this Policy, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce agreements.

11.2. Retention periods may vary depending on the type of information and the purposes for which it was collected. To request deletion of your Personal Information, see Section 13 (Your Rights).

## **12. Children's Privacy**

12.1. The Services are not directed to children under the age of 13 (or the minimum age in your jurisdiction). We do not knowingly collect Personal Information from children without parental consent.

12.2. If you believe we have collected Personal Information from a child without appropriate consent, contact us at [CONTACT EMAIL]. We will delete such information as required by law.

## **13. Your Rights and Choices**

13.1. Access and Correction: You may request access to the Personal Information we hold about you and request that we correct inaccurate or incomplete information.

13.2. Deletion: You may request deletion of your Personal Information subject to applicable legal exceptions.

13.3. Data Portability: Where applicable, you may request a copy of your Personal Information in a machine-readable format.

13.4. Objection and Restriction: You may object to or request restriction of certain processing activities where applicable.

13.5. Marketing Opt-Out: You can opt out of marketing communications by following the unsubscribe instructions in those communications or by contacting [CONTACT EMAIL].

13.6. To exercise rights, submit a request to [CONTACT EMAIL] with sufficient detail to identify you and the request. We may require verification of identity before fulfilling requests.

## **14. California and Other State Privacy Rights**

14.1. If you are a resident of California, you may have additional rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) / California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), including the right to request disclosure of personal information categories collected, sold, or shared; the right to opt out of sale or sharing of personal information; and the right to non-discrimination for exercising these rights.

## **15. European Economic Area / United Kingdom (if applicable)**

## **16. Changes to this Policy**

16.1. We may update this Policy from time to time. When we make material changes, we will notify you by

posting a prominent notice on the Services, sending an email to account holders, or as otherwise required by law. The "Effective Date" at the top of this Policy will be updated.

## **17. Miscellaneous**

17.1. Severability: If a court finds any provision of this Policy invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in effect.

17.2. No Waiver: Our failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver of our rights.
